Success Story: ASU/Psychology Lab

Researchers at the Behavioral Neuroscience division of the Psychology Department at ASU study aging and neurodegenerative diseases, learning and memory, and behavioral and neurobiological consequences.

The Behavioral Neuroscience research area underwent substantial renovation in 2010, creating four new wet and dry laboratories, a surgical suite and an integrated stereology/microscopy room. A state-of-the-art, automated animal heating thermostat in the post-surgical recovery area was a collaboration with Symbiote engineering and mercatUS International in Phoenix.

The area enables extensive opportunities to work on new projects and form additional collaborations. Symbiote's UltraFrame Laboratory furniture was specified by the architect. Fixed casework and flexible islands, with vertical utility chases for lab gases and vacuum, allow for future growth.
