Success Story: ASU/Doane Lab

Arizona State University, Department of Psychology, presented a renovation opportunity in 2011 and the interchangeable UltraFrame Laboratory system was the answer.

The Doane Laboratory project, specified by mercatUS International in Phoenix, originated as an office space. The goal was to transform the area into a functional laboratory to accommodate up to three scientists or graduate students. Its purpose? To conduct research and prepare experiments for classroom use.

The furniture design needed to both satisfy the principal researcher's specific requirements and easily allow for reconfiguration of counter heights to accommodate future ADA requirements. This was accomplished by installing a rolling lower cabinet and epoxy worksurfaces with height adjustable legs. No frame was mounted to alleviate obstruction under the worksurface, providing the University with an adaptable furniture solution.
