Success Story: ASU/UCENT

The University Center (UCENT) building at the Arizona State University, downtown Phoenix Campus, boasts modern classrooms, offices, labs, seminar rooms and study areas. ASU, a catalyst for growth in the downtown area, is a key component to the state's Bio-Medical Industry.

ASU's growth dictates the need to accommodate more educational disciplines. An increased course load and limited classrooms require flexible rooms that maximize their function. Labs must perform double duty as science classrooms, combining research activities with ample lecture seating.

To unify an ADA accessible classroom with a lab requires power access and worksurface stability for costly equipment. The solution? Symbiote height adjustable 4-Legged Tables and a suspended power chase beneath epoxy tops. The new floorplan increases space utilization and reduces student movement and overall facility cost. The project was a collaboration with the instructors and mercatUS International in Phoenix.
